

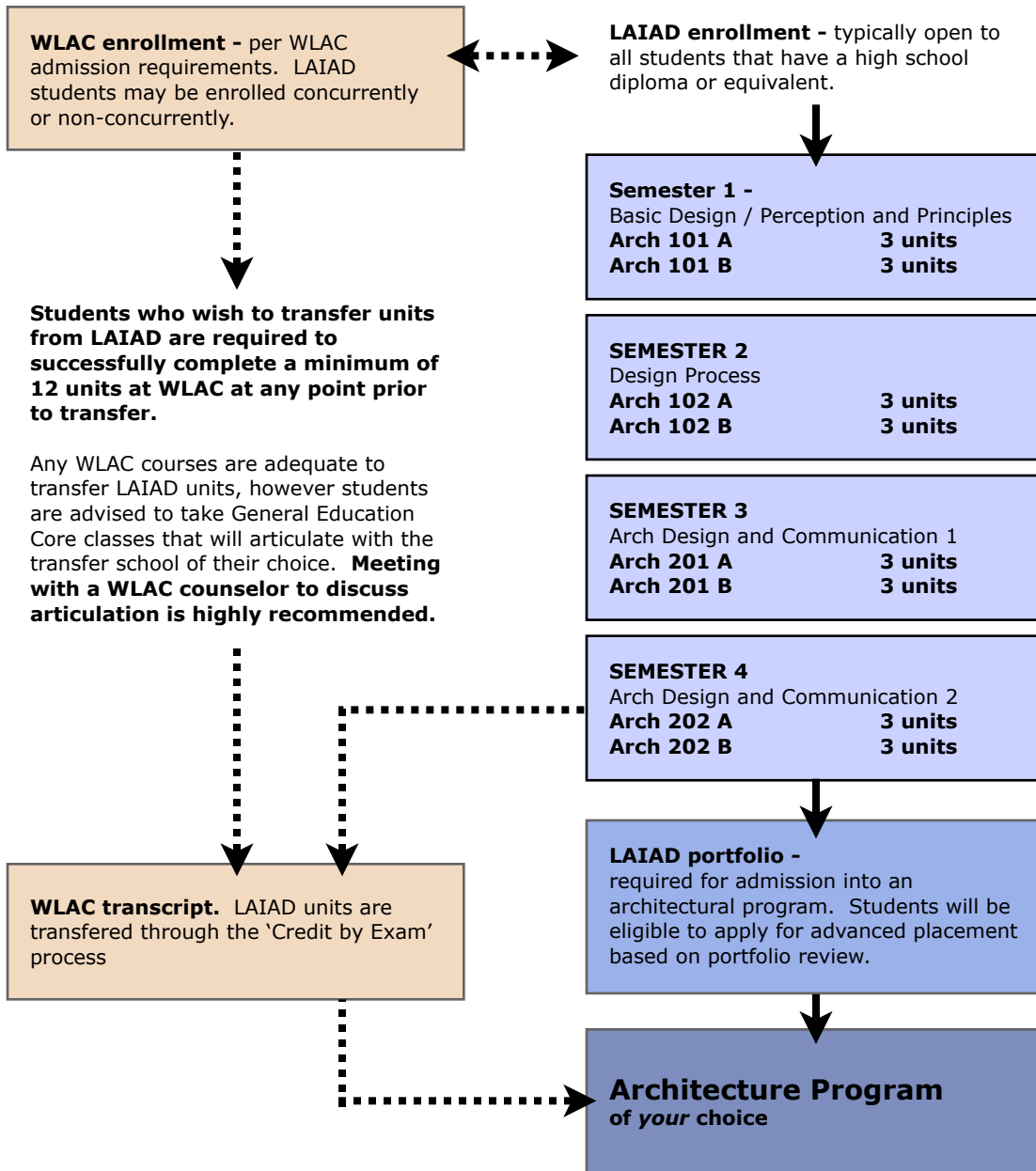
WLAC / LAIAD curriculum flowchart

Architecture Transfer Program

LA Institute of Architecture and Design's Architecture Transfer Program is intended for students who want to pursue a professional (B Arch*) degree in architecture. LAIAD's curriculum focuses on the most difficult aspects of the architectural practice, specifically conceptual thinking, design process, and visual communication. Students should be aware that LAIAD does not focus on vocational training and that other programs within the LACC system may have a greater emphasis on specific job skills.
